SAAUC provides the following to its members:

AppleSauce: the Club's monthly magazine presents advice, information and interesting articles from members and others from Australia and overseas

Library: members can borrow books and CD-ROMs covering topics such as AppleWorks, iMovie, iPhoto, FileMaker, Word, Excel, and Photoshop, as well as general information

Bulk Purchases: SAAUC from time to time makes bulk purchases of software and inks for printers. Members can save more than the cost of their annual subscription
